#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

PGY1/PGY2 residents are to fulfill teaching requirements as defined by their Pharmacy Residency program.

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to establish standardized teaching requirements for Pharmacy residents.

#### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all residents of the UKHC Pharmacy Residency programs.

#### **PROCEDURES**

- 1. Teaching Requirements
  - a. PGY1 and PGY2 residents
    - i. Precept or co-precept all students on rotation with the preceptor
    - i. PGY1 Laboratory facilitation for 16 contact hours per year
    - ii. PGY2 Laboratory facilitation or analogous experience (small group facilitation, teaching assistant, etc.) for 8 contact hours per year
    - iii. Lectures (in-class teaching) as specified by program year
  - b. Laboratory or Small Group Facilitation
    - i. Residents will facilitate 16 (PGY1) or 8 hours (PGY2) of contact time per year of laboratory for UK College of Pharmacy professional students or participate in an analogous experience. Program directors will work with their residents to select optimal teaching activities. The dates and times for laboratory facilitation must be distributed to the Resident Listserv no later than August 1 for distribution to program directors. These dates, times, and topics are to be developed collaboratively with College of Pharmacy patient care laboratory faculty. Residents should proactively communicate expectations of the current learning experience to the faculty/course coordinator and the teaching date(s)/activities to their RPD and preceptor.
  - c. Large Classroom Lectures or Facilitation
    - i. PGY1 residents will prepare and deliver a minimum of 1 contact hour of classroom time at the UK College of Pharmacy or other health colleges per year. Topics and expectations will be provided to residents no later than 1 month prior to the scheduled class.
    - ii. PGY2 residents will prepare and deliver a minimum of 1 contact hour of classroom time at

the UK College of Pharmacy or other health colleges per year. Topics will primarily be in the resident's area of focus within the Integrated Drugs and Diseases Courses or other relevant courses. Topics will be provided to residents no later than 1 month prior to the scheduled class.

# 2. Additional Requirements

a. All pharmacy residents will be encouraged to complete the ASHP/UKCOP Teaching and Learning Certificate (TLC). Teaching activities fulfilled by the TLC will count toward the minimum annual teaching requirements. Residents who have already completed a certificate program at another site do not have to complete the ASHP/UKCOP TLC but still engage in the teaching requirements as detailed above.
